

Deed Transfer Tax By-law

1. This By-law is entitled the “Deed Transfer Tax By-law”.
2. A deed transfer tax applies in the Municipality of the District of Digby.
3. The rate of the deed transfer tax in the Municipality of the District of Digby is one half of one percent (0.5) of the value of the property transferred.
4. Sections 102 to 110 of the Municipal Government Act apply to the Municipality of the District of Digby.
5. The Registrar of Deeds shall be the agent and collector of the deed transfer tax for the Municipality of the District of Digby in accordance with the agreement to that effect between the Municipality of the District of Digby and the Minister of Service Nova Scotia and Municipal Relations.
