











Important Notice Regarding Recycling Program

Please note that effective October 20, 2008 the Municipality of the District of Digby will be **stickering and rejecting contaminated blue bags**. This is an important next step in the waste management program and recycling contract implemented January 1, 2007. Blue bags contaminated with organics and garbage cause serious problems with the recycling facility and should be included with your green bin or clear bag garbage pickup.

The recycling facility requires that recyclables be placed in two separate bags for recycling, one for paper, one for containers. Recycling bags containing only paper require less sorting and will be baled and made into products like egg cartons and take out trays right here in Nova Scotia!
